Bronze certificates are earned by getting 1000 points in a week (Monday morning to Sunday night), about 5-10 activities in total. Just check the rocket ship to see your weekly progress.

Congratulations also to **1/20 who were last week's leading class with 13 certificates**. Second place goes to 5/6M (6) and third to 3/4K (3). Just remember students have full 24hr access to Mathletics on the Internet and therefore can complete activities at home if they wish.
