Cyberbullying and the protection of students.

What can you do to protect your child?

1. Talk to your child

- Discuss online safety and reassure your child that you are there to help if they need it.

2. Provide safe and supervised access

- Keep your family computer in a high traffic area so you can keep an eye on your child's technology use.
- Install safety software on your computer. For example, anti-virus, spy ware, a firewall and filters. Free internet content filters are available at www.netalert.gov.au

3. Monitor technology use

- Take an interest in what your child is doing online.
- Remind your child of 'stranger danger', they might think they are talking to another child but it could be an adult.

4. Get involved and be aware

- Has your child's behaviour changed recently? Are they spending more or less time online? Are your mobile phone bills suddenly through the roof?
- Encourage your child to come to you if anybody says or does anything to make them feel uncomfortable.

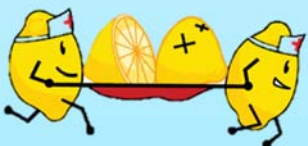

Our average results on the “first” attempt was 78.2% correct. **The “latest” attempts average 90.3% correct.** At this stage of the year, our attempted results are **19278 → above 85%, 5884 → between 84%-50% and 1882 → below 50%.** Well done everyone.

Mathletics Update



Another successful week for Mathletics at Eden Public. We had 1 student achieve their Gold Certificate and 6 students achieve their Silver Certificates. We also had 16 Bronze Certificates achieved last week. Well done everyone! Remember to get a Silver certificate you must get four Bronze certificates. Bronze certificates are earned by **getting 1000 points in a week** (Monday morning to Sunday night), about 5-10 activities in total. Just check the rocket ship to see your weekly progress.

The uniform shop will be open on Tuesday 28th November from 2:30pm – 4pm and again on Saturday 9th December 9am-12pm





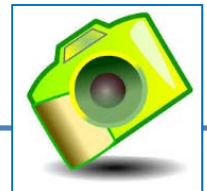
