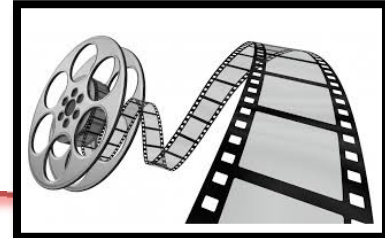




STAGE 2 AND 3 CELEBRATION DAY
