Book Week - Author Visit: Susie Sarah

As part of the book week celebrations, we have a visiting author at the school on Thursday this week. All students will have an opportunity to engage with Susie Sarah throughout the day. The program for the day revolves around creating rhymes and stories, performing them and producing artwork to complement the stories. Each session is very interactive.

NAPLAN ONLINE: READINESS TEST

Next week, students in grades 3 and 5 will take part in the NAPLAN Online Readiness Test. This readiness test is a state-wide initiative in preparation for the move to an online version of NAPLAN in the future. The main purpose is to test the online testing environment and school based infrastructure. Individual results will not be processed or reported upon. **Please note**: Students who were exempt during this year's NAPLAN Test are still considered to be exempt, unless parents contact the school to permit access to the NAPLAN ONLINE Readiness test.

Tell Them From Me Survey – week 7

I am delighted that this term, our school, like many other public schools in the state, will participate in a Department of Education initiative: the *Tell Them From Me* student feedback survey. The survey measures factors that are known to affect academic achievement and other student outcomes. The focus of the NSW-wide survey is on student wellbeing, engagement and effective teaching practices.

You may remember that our students also participated in a *Tell Them From Me* student survey in Term 1 this year. Asking students to complete the survey twice in one year allows us to identify trends in student responses as well as track engagement and motivation across the school year.

The survey is a great opportunity for our students to provide us with valuable and quick feedback on what they think about school life, how engaged they are with school and the different ways that teachers interact with them. More than 6,300 schools in Australia and around the world have used *Tell Them From Me* to survey 5.4 million students. Capturing the voices of our students will help improve how we do things at our school.

I want to assure you that the survey is confidential. The survey is conducted online and will typically take less than 30 minutes to complete. It will be administered during school hours between 27 August and 26 October. Participating in the survey is entirely voluntary.

If you <u>do</u> <u>not</u> want your child or children to participate, please return the form to school by **Friday 31**st **August,2018**. EARLY ACTION FOR SUCCESS


Mrs Caldwell and 1C
