#### Tips for parents in reducing the spread of head lice.

It was very pleasing to see 1 GOLD Certificate, 4 Silver Certificates and 22 Bronze Certificates achieved over the holidays and the first few weeks of school. Well done everyone! Remember to get a Silver certificate you must get four Bronze certificates. Bronze certificates are earned by getting 1000 points in a week (Monday morning to Sunday night), about 5-10 activities in total. #### Students are using Mathletics and Reading Eggs in 2021

All students at Eden Public School will be using the world wide online educational resources: Mathletics and Reading Eggs (almost 5 million users) in 2021. These programs are used to support student understanding and improve their results in Mathematics and reading. The activities in each program are enjoyable for students to use and motivating. Both programs can be accessed 24hrs / 7 days a week on the Internet.

At this stage, most students, except Kindergarten, have been issued with their passwords. However, there are a few key points to remember when using the programs:

#### Mathletics

- In order to get the best results and earn a certificate, students need to complete a minimum of 1000 points per week (Monday to Sunday night).
- To achieve 1000 points a student needs to complete approximately 5 activities per week. These
  activities do not need to be completed in one night but can be accumulated throughout the
  week. It is also important to note that getting 3000 points in one week only equates to one
  certificate not 3.
- Certificates build upon each other to increase the level of recognition ie: 5 bronze = 1 silver, 5 silvers = 1 gold.
- Silver and Gold Certificates are presented at our big assemblies and student recognition is also given in the weekly newsletter.
- Students are encouraged to revisit activities they have already successfully completed to maintain their mathematical knowledge.
- Participation in the Games, Problem Solving and Live Maths sections also acquire points towards the weekly total.
- Your child's classroom teacher has their login and password details.
- Mathletics App for iPad/iPod and Android is available for download.

#### Reading Eggs

- Reading Eggs has two components: Reading Eggs (Infants) and Reading Eggspress (Primary).
- In Reading Eggs, students' progress along a "footpath" of activities designed to reinforce their reading skills.
- As part of Reading Eggspress students have targets to hit. These included reading a certain number of online books and completing a series of comprehension questions, etc. Once the targets have been completed, the next level of targets is made available.
- Certificates are not a part of either Reading Eggs or Reading Eggspress.
- Students do not have a weekly quota to achieve.
- Your child's classroom teacher has their login and password details.
- A Reading Eggs App for iPad/iPod and Android is available for download.

#### **EPS Behaviour System 2021**

Our behaviour support system increases the amount of contact between the school and parents, regarding any ongoing inappropriate student behaviour. Better communication around a student's behaviour is an aspect of the school, parents wanted to see improve. This system, listed below, will have parents contacted after; 3 reflections (minor classroom behaviours), 3 Minor Detentionable Incidents, 2 Major Detentionable Incidents, 3 Major Detentionable Incidents, 5 Major Detentionable Incidents, 6 Major Detentionable Incidents, and any form of suspension. The idea behind this improved communication is so behavior redirection can be more easily completed as a partnership between parents and the school.

- Inappropriate Class Behaviour = Stage based Reflection (10 minutes out of the playground at recess to reflect on and discuss behaviour).
- **3 Reflections** in a term = Minor Detention (completed by student) and classroom teacher to contact parent.
- 3 Minor Detentionable Incidents = Student completes 1 Major
   Detention and text sent to parents regarding inappropriate behaviour,
   parents advised to contact the school to discuss incidents.
- **2 Major Detentionable Incidents** = Student completes detentions, text and note sent to parents advising consequences of ongoing inappropriate behaviour.
- 3 Major Detentionable Incidents = Student completes detentions, text sent to parents, parents advised to contact the school to discuss incidents, student placed on a behaviour monitoring card. While on the monitoring card, student is not eligible to participate in any extracurricular activities (Rep. sport, fete days, school camps/excursions, visiting performances, SCLC/choir performances, garden club) or hold positions of responsibility. These activities are reinstated after the successful completion of the monitoring period (i.e. 2 weeks without any inappropriate behaviour).
- **5 Major Detentionable Incidents** = Student completes detentions, text and note sent to parents advising consequences of ongoing inappropriate behaviour.
- **6 Major Detentionable Incidents** = Student completes detentions, text sent to parents, parents requested to attend an interview to


discuss ongoing behaviour, warning of suspension letter issued, student placed on a behaviour monitoring card. Students are not eligible to participate in any extracurricular activities (Rep. sport, fete days, school camps/excursions, visiting performances, SCLC/choir performances, garden club) or hold positions of responsibility **for the remainder of the term**. These activities will be reinstated at the beginning of the next term, upon the successful completion of any outstanding detentions.

Any Suspension (in-school, short or long) = student suspended, parents contacted, student placed on a behaviour monitoring card. Students are not eligible to participate in any extracurricular activities (Rep. sport, fete days, school camps/excursions, visiting performances, SCLC/choir performances, garden club) or hold positions of responsibility for the remainder of the term. These activities will be reinstated at the beginning of the next term, upon the successful completion of any outstanding detentions.

#### NOTE:

- Students refusing to attend detention will automatically be given an "extra" detention of <u>equal value</u> to the detention they have refused to attend.
- If a student receives two (2) minor detentions on the same day, these "half" detention will be completed the following school day as a full lunch detention, but will be recorded as two minor detentions.
- Catch-up or outstanding detentions from a previous term
- Any detentions not completed during a term, will be caught up in the following term. During this "catch-up" period, students will not be able to participate in any extracurricular activities, until the previous detentions have been completed. These "catch-up" detentions do not get added to the current term's detention record (ie. They were from last term, not this term).
