NAPLAN

All students in Year 3 and Year 5 will sit the NAPLAN tests over the next two weeks. It's important that your child participates in these assessments as they give informative data to the school and to you about your child and their performance.

This year our students will participate in the online NAPLAN assessments. Every student is familiar with the online NAPLAN format and have had the opportunity to trial the types of test questions, and understand the interactive platform and tools to support the assessment. These assessments provide information about a child's progress at one point in time and students are supported to feel confident to complete the test and relaxed in the formal test setting. Please make your child feel comfortable about these tests and encourage them to do their best.

Morning arrivals

Please ensure that students are not dropped at school before 8.40 as there is minimal supervision before this time. All students in Year 1 to 6 need to sit on the silver seats on the top playground until a teacher is present. Kindergarten students need to stay in the Stage 1 classroom area until a teacher arrives. We appreciate your support with this.
