#### SCLC Performing Arts Festival





## GARDEN NEWS....

It has been a busy couple of terms in the garden. As always the students have had fun digging, watering, planting and hunting for worms and ladybugs.

We managed to harvest a bumper crop of pumpkins which were shared amongst our budding gardeners. Each week they tended their chosen pumpkin, with some even giving them names! The school canteen also made use of the pumpkins and staff were happy to purchase some as well. All money raised by selling our produce goes back into purchasing seeds or tools.

Students have been busy planting winter crops of beans, peas, brassicas, onions, silverbeet and beetroot. They have constructed tree guards to protect the young plants. They have also been propagating plants to use in future garden beds around the school.

Watering the plants is a favourite activity, and thanks to the abundant rainfall, plenty of water has collected in our tanks. The worm farms are working beautifully and are creating litres of worm juice and compost for the garden beds.

We have made use of the school chipper this term and have been able to create mulch for various gardens around the school.

This year, each class has been rostered a time in the garden. Students work with Marty to learn new skills, have fun, and develop self-confidence by spending time in the garden tending plants and growing food. The younger classes are assisted by our Stage 3 Garden Assistants.

Remember: Garden Club is open to all students every Wednesday at lunchtime.





# Green Gang News

Students of Eden Public School have been making a fantastic effort with our waste program. Aided by the dedicated members of the Green Gang, they have been sorting their rubbish into the **Red** (general waste), **Yellow** (recycling) and **Green** (FOGO) bins as well as feeding our garden's worm farm.

The school canteen is providing lunches in compostable containers and this is helping to reduce the amount of waste going into landfill.

Next term, some of our students will take part in an excursion that will allow them to see first-hand the Central Waste Facility (landfill site near Wolumla), the new Merimbula FOGO site and the transfer station and community recycling centre (also at Merimbula). Amber Gault, waste officer from the Bega Valley Shire Council, will be joining them on the day. Amber, and other council staff, will speak with the students as they are guided through the sites.

We are always looking at ways to increase our efforts, and with the support of the SRC, a new program is about to be launched. But you will have to wait until next term when all will be revealed!

A big thank-you must go out to all members of the Green Gang. It is their enthusiasm and dedication that is helping to make Eden Public School a clean and sustainable environment.
