More information will be provided next week.

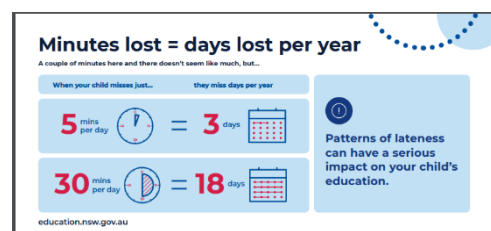


### **Breakfast Club**

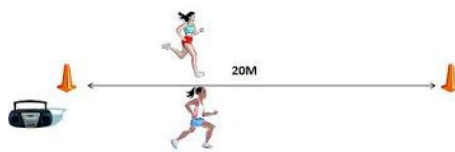

# WHATS HAPPENING IN PE THIS TERM!
