Attendance Matters

Education for your child is important and regular attendance at school is essential for your child to achieve their educational best and increase their career and life options. NSW public schools work in partnership with parents to encourage and support regular attendance of children and young people. When your child attends school every day, learning becomes easier, and your child will build and maintain friendships with other children.

What if my child must be away from school?

On occasion, your child may need to be absent from school. Justified reasons for student absences may include:

- being sick, or having an infectious disease
- Laving an unavoidable medical appointment
- Arr exceptional or urgent family circumstance (e.g. attending a funeral)

It is vital that all absences are explained!

If a child is away for 3 days, parent reply to absent text message needs to state all the dates that the child was sick. EG- Jack was sick 12/5 – 15/5/22. (Rather than just stating sick, because this is recorded only for 1 day)


