Congratulations to our district cross country runners who were amazing representatives for our school at Wolumla. We are super proud of their sportsmanship, determination and resilience!

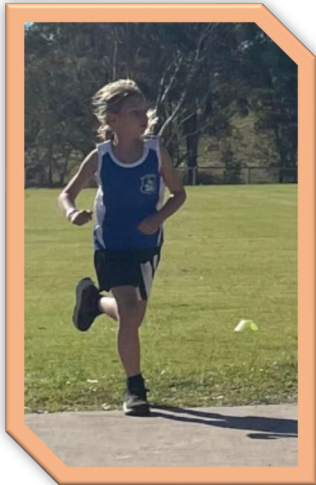

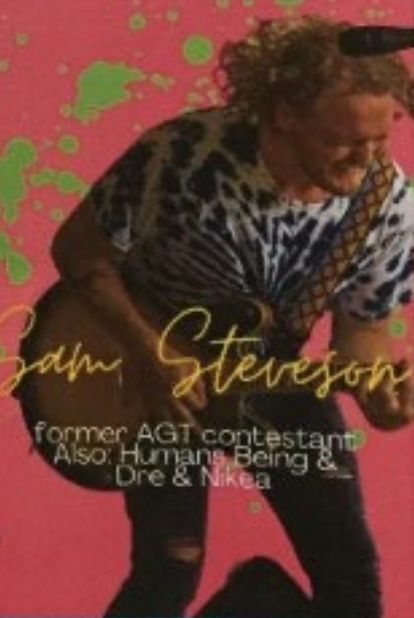
