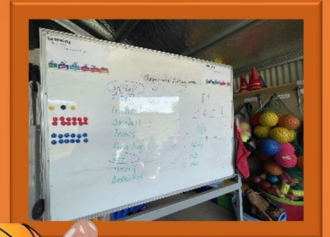
WHAT'S GOING ON THIS TERM IN



This term is going so fast and we are now in week 4 of the our PE programs. Kindy's are learning the elements of dance for the first time in primary school and they are movers and shakers. They are developing their confidence in creating physical sequences in rhythm and beats to music. In the opposite years of 5&6, students have gone through the earlier years of EPS dance programs, that has developed their skills and knowledge of the dance elements. 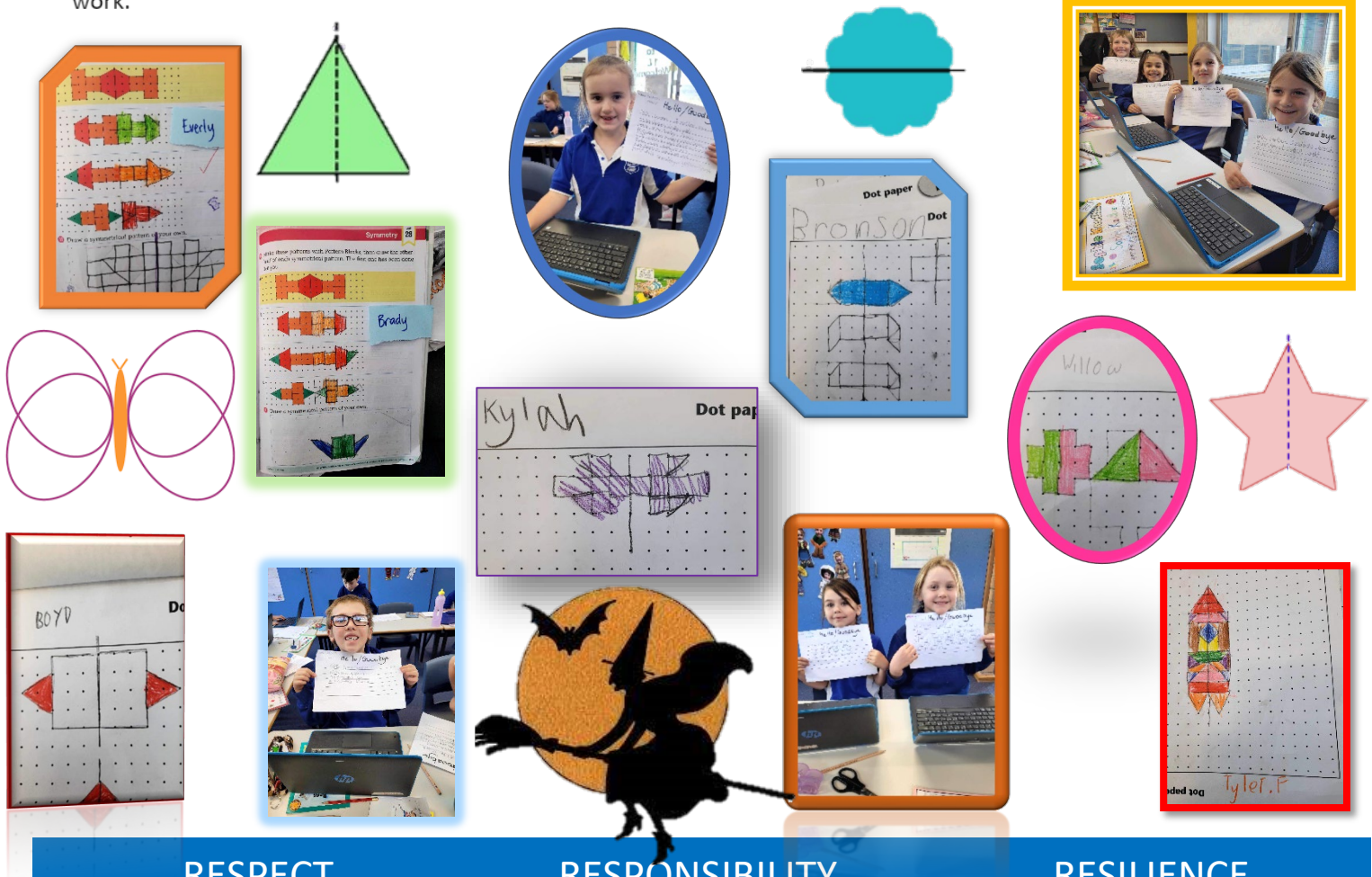


What's going on in 1L

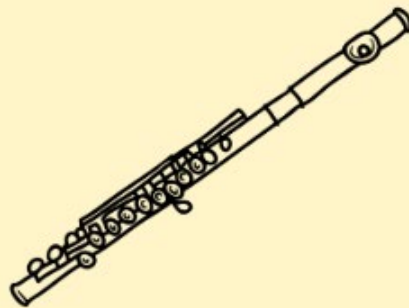

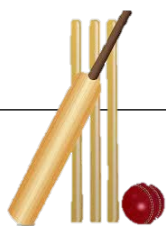

Elective Sport Program 2023



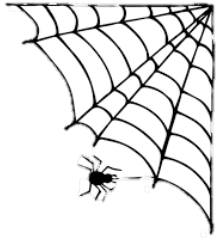
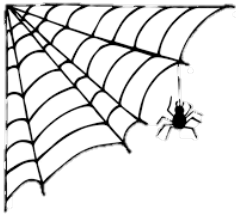
